On May 21st K-2nd were able to attend a performance of Pinkalicious.

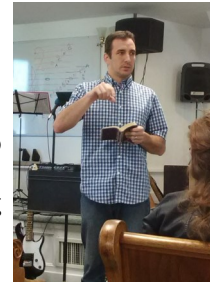


National Day Of Prayer

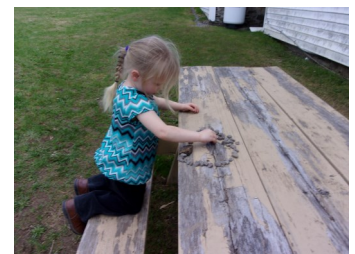
Calendar Raffle
